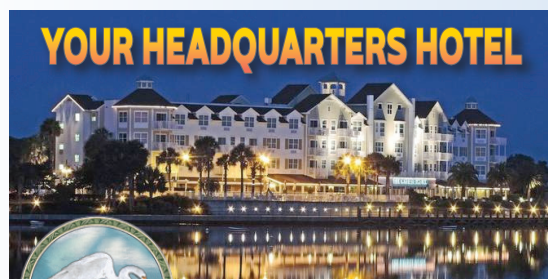

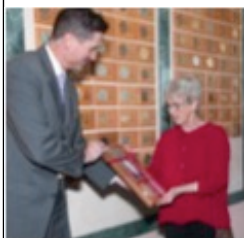

- Exit the airport; follow signs to Beachline Expressway/SR 528
- Take Beachline/SR 528 West, through two toll booths, to the Florida Turnpike (Exit 4)
- Take Florida Turnpike North (Ocala) to Wildwood (Exit 304), then US 301 North
- Turn right onto SR 44
- Turn left onto Powell Road
- Turn right onto 466A
- Turn left onto Buena Vista Boulevard
- Continue through six roundabouts for approximately 6.5 miles
- Turn right onto Old Mill Run
- Turn left onto Lakeshore Dr.
- The Waterfront Inn is located on the left
